ENTRY INFORMATION

- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid
- Entry fees are \$22 for the 1st entry of a dog and \$12 for the additional entry of the same dog PER DAY
- Make checks or money orders payable to ESSFTA and mail to the Trial Secretary at the address above
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, fees and back of entry form with agreement signed, nor will credit cards or faxed entries be accepted
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. No refund for duplicate entries.
- **If you use a delivery service or USPS priority mail, you MUST check the "no signature required" box** as the Trial Secretary will not be present to sign for your entries. Failure to check this box will cause a delay in receipt of your entry and possible failure to make the limited trial size.

TRIAL HOURS

Judging will begin no earlier than 8:30 a.m. on both days. Exact running order will be determined after entries close and will be provided in the Judging Program.

- Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by Trial Committee action. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency or any other cause beyond the control of the committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries will not be accepted.
- Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial, and no refunds will be made if an exhibitor pulls an entry for this reason.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of the dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run.
- ESSFTA and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide a public address system or stewards to call or locate dogs that are not present at the ring when required.
- ESSFTA and the Georgia National Fairgrounds & AgriCenter assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

All dogs (meaning either sex) twelve (12) months of age or older that have an AKC registration number or Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) number may enter this trial. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class may participate provided they are AKC-registered. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect their physical or mental performance may not be entered.

CLASSES & TITLES OFFERED

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no cross-over between classes allowed at the same set of trials. Standard classes offered are: Novice Agility (NA), Novice Agility Preferred (NAP), Open Agility (OA), Open Agility Preferred (OAP), Agility Excellent (AX), Agility Excellent Preferred (AXP), Master Agility Excellent (MX) and Master Agility Excellent Preferred (MXP). JWW classes offered are Novice JWW (NAJ), Novice JWW Preferred (NJP), Open JWW (OAJ), Open JWW Preferred (OJP), Agility Excellent JWW (AXJ), Agility Excellent JWW Preferred (AXP), Master Agility Excellent JWW (MXJ) and Master Agility Excellent JWW Preferred (MJP).

MOVE-UPS

Dogs (English Springer Spaniels only) qualifying for a title on November 8 may move up to a higher class on Tuesday, November 9 provided a move-up form (available at the trial site) is submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes after the end of judging on Monday, November 8.

RIBBONS & ROSETTES

A green qualifying ribbon will be awarded for all qualifying scores. Rosettes and dog toys will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each class and jump height. Dogs must qualify to receive a placement. MACH rosettes and a MACH "diploma" will be presented to any exhibitor achieving a MACH title.

A special award for High in Trial English Springer Spaniel will be awarded following the All-Breed Trial on Monday, November 8.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS/JUDGING PROGRAMS

An initial email confirmation is sent only if the email address is *legibly printed* on the entry form. If you cannot receive a Word attachment, or if you do not check your email, do NOT include your email address. Printed confirmations are mailed to exhibitors without email addresses. Please contact the Trial Secretary by phone, fax or email to report any errors. **Correct AKC registration # or ILP # is crucial so that legs/titles are credited properly.**

The Judging Program is mailed with a final entry confirmation to the owner's address. If you want this information sent to the handler (if different from owner), please specify on your entry. If any exhibitor does not receive the Judging Program within five (5) days of the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

ALL-BREED AGILITY TRIAL INFORMATION - WEEKEND OF NOVEMBER 6-7

The Four Paw Agility Club of North Georgia will be holding an all-breed agility trial the weekend before the ESSFTA trials. The trials will be Saturday & Sunday, November 6 & 7 in Alpharetta, Georgia which is approximately 30 miles north of Atlanta. These trials open on September 3 and close on October 1.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- All dogs present **must** be on leash or confined in crates or ex-pens when not being judged; no dogs under six months of age allowed on grounds.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

The town of Perry is approximately 115 miles south of Atlanta on Interstate 75. Traveling either north or south on I-75, you may take either Exit 134 or Exit 135. Signage will be posted on site, and more specific directions once inside the fairgrounds along with a map will be provided with the Judging Program.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS FOR REGULAR & PREFERRED CLASSES

Owners are responsible for entering their dog in the proper height division. All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time **MUST** enter at the **NOVICE** level in both Preferred Standard and Preferred JWW. The jump heights below **MUST** be used in Preferred Classes (i.e., you cannot elect to enter a different jump height based upon the height of your dog).

Regular Classes

8 Inches	For dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
12 Inches	For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16 Inches	For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers

AKC JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

All dogs competing in AKC Agility must have an official AKC Jump Height Card. All dogs **except those jumping 24"** (unless an AKC Agility Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official is present) without official height cards will be measured for the weekend's competition. ESSFTA will accept a photocopy of your dog's jump height card which should be submitted along with each entry form and fees.

If you do not send a photocopy of the jump height card with your entry, you **MUST** present it for verification that your dog is entered in the correct class, or your dog must be measured before you receive your armbands. Any dogs found to be entered in a **lower** jump height than allowed will be moved to the correct jump height immediately. Each exhibitor is responsible for having his/her dog(s) measured. All exhibitors should carry the official AKC Jump Height Card with them. **Dogs will be ineligible to compete if the above requirements are not met.**

RING DIMENSIONS

The trial will be held in an outdoor covered arena on packed dirt; ring size is approximately 100' x 100' (10,000 square feet).

ARMAND REQUIREMENT

All competitors MUST wear armband(s) while running. Competitors will not be admitted to the rings without their armband(s) visible.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

- Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. Prior to the start of class, novice handlers will be given a familiarization period to take dogs over the contact obstacles only. Contact familiarization on Tuesday is open only to dogs not entered on Monday.
- All obstacles conform to the requirements in the most current edition of the AKC Regulations Applying to Agility.
